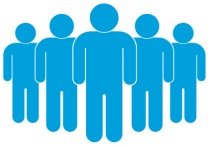

2020 CARE BY NUMBERS



In 2020 we proudly served **36,001** patients through **14** clinics throughout Pasco and Hernando Counties.



Provided **7,833** FREE Covid-19 tests to community members through drive-thru clinics and events.



We served **1,377** Migrant Seasonal Agricultural Workers (MSAW).



We served **3,036** homeless throughout Pasco and Hernando Counties.

49% were at 100% of the FPL
67% were at 200% of the FPL
Federal Poverty Level (FPL)



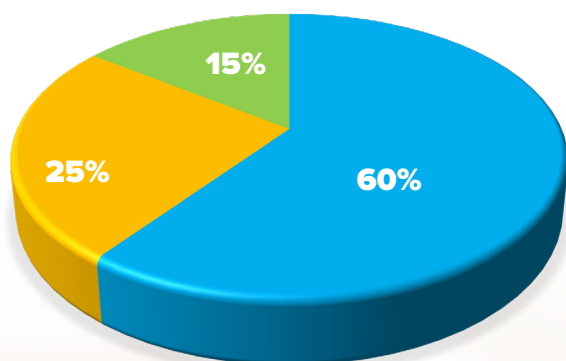
In response to the stay at home order, **2,052** Telehealth video visits were made available for Premier patients providing safe and accessible care.

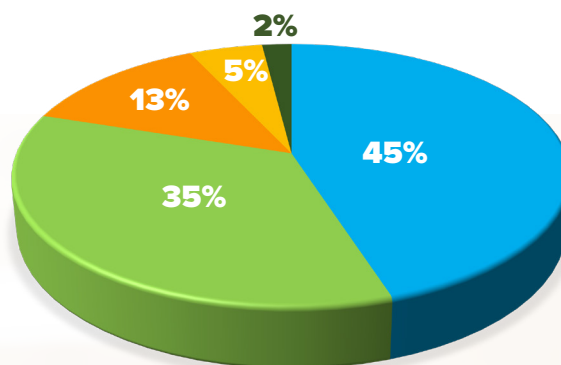

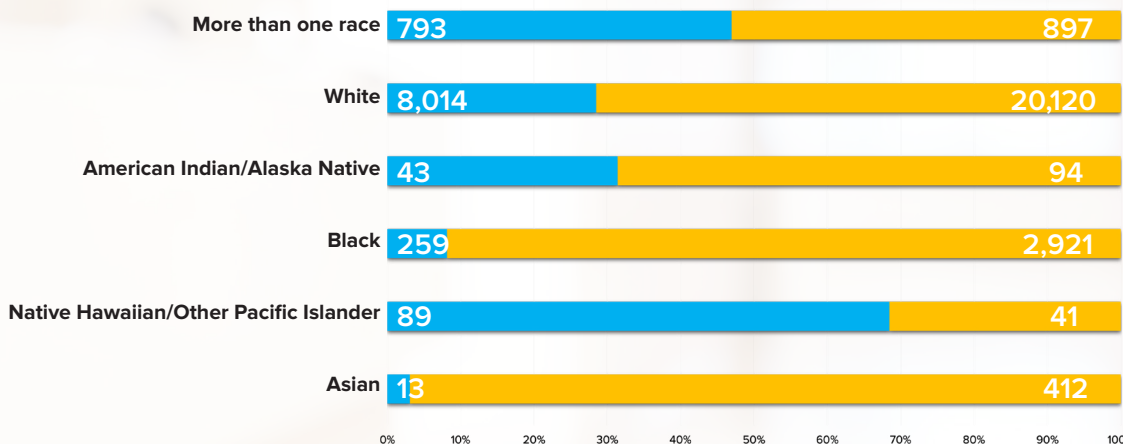
